WHAT DOES THE REPORT COVER?

The 55 page report covers responses from 124 colleges representing over half a million students and nearly 40,000 full and part-time lecturers. The report covers both the ICT and e-learning provisions in colleges.

Topics covered include learning management systems; e-portfolio solutions; computer hardware and broadband provision as well as how colleges choose and use their ICT and e-learning resources. A full chapter outline is provided on Pages 2-3 below.

WHAT WAS THE TARGET AUDIENCE AND HOW WAS THE RESEARCH CONDUCTED?

The 'ICT & E-learning in Colleges' research project commenced with a postal campaign to 467 further and sixth form colleges on 12 September. Additionally, an email and telephone campaign was used to encourage completion.

Our issued letters/emails had 161 named IT Managers and 225 named E-learning Managers. The remaining letters were sent to generic headings. In all instances a questionnaire was sent to both the IT and the E-learning contact with the request that the other party may be best placed to answer some questions so as to ensure comprehensive completion of all questionnaires.
